Introduction

All data in this report are for FY2007 with the exception of salaries, staffing and educational level data that are current as of 7-1-07. Libraries that did not report data are included only in the tables on page 9, the pie chart on page 10 and on the maps throughout the report.

The purpose of this report is to support long-range planning, strengthen service evaluation and advance informed decision making. Thank you to the library directors and staff members who spent considerable time and effort compiling the data summarized here. Their work is greatly appreciated.

Massachusetts Public Library Quick Facts

On June 30, 2007, there were 370 public libraries, 106 branch libraries and four bookmobiles in Massachusetts.

On a typical day in FY2007, Massachusetts public libraries:

- held 270 programs for children and adults
- circulated 142,810 items
- answered 14,180 reference questions
- were visited by 85,299 people
- hosted 27,665 Internet access sessions

In FY2007, Massachusetts public libraries:

- held 6.8 books, magazines, cds, video and audio tapes, computer software & more for each Massachusetts resident
- were visited an average of 6.6 times per person
- circulated 8.2 items per person
- lent and borrowed 9,978,437 items for patrons through the statewide interlibrary loan cooperative program
- had 4,806 computers offering Internet access for patron use

In FY2007:

- the average public library expenditure in a municipality was \$36.95 per person.
- the average cost of a book was \$54.
- if each person purchased the average number of items borrowed, the cost would have been \$441 per person.
- municipalities appropriated \$34.00 per capita to public libraries.
- libraries spent \$5.67 per capita for library materials.



Sr. & Library Techs FTE	Full-time equivalency for two classifications of library staff positions that perform circulation, processing, or public service duties (not general clerical work). Senior Library Technicians perform more complex duties than Library Technicians though in the same areas and may have supervisory responsibilities
Salary Expenditures	Salary and wages for all library staff including plant operations, security and maintenance staff expended from the library's budget. Includes salaries and wages before deductions. Excludes benefits.

Weekly Duplicated Hours Open	Sum of the annual hours the main library and its branches were open, divided by 52.
Weekly Users of Internet Computers	Average weekly number of individuals who used the library's public Internet computers, regardless of length of time. If computers were used for multiple purposes (Internet access, word processing, OPAC, etc.) and Internet users could not be isolated, all usage was reported.
Weekly Volunteer Hours	Estimate of annual number of hours worked by a library's volunteers, divided by 52.

Staffing level data includes: total full-time equivalencies (FTE), number full time and part time, and FTE for MLS, librarian, children's librarian and non-custodian positions as well as total hours open per non-custodian FTE. Director's education level and length of work week are displayed.

➤ Electronic Services, FYxxxx Data (available in May)

Selected statistics related to electronic services including: website hits, number of users of public Internet computers, electronic subscriptions and materials in electronic format.

➤ Featured Reports, FYxxxx Data (available in the spring)

Reports on changing topics present public library data not displayed in other reports.

➤ Financial Statistics Report, FYxxxx Data (available in February)

Raw and per capita figures for each reporting public library's (including branches) total municipal appropriation, operating income, and salary, materials, other and total operating expenditures. Also included are percent of total operating expenditures spent for salaries, materials and other expenditures.

➤ The FYxxxx Municipal Pie...What's Your Share? (available in January)

Relates the amount expended from the general fund by each city and town on public library service, to the amount expended to operate the entire municipality.

➤ Public Library Outlets, FYxxxx Data (available in May)

Selected statistics relating to public library outlets including: staffing, holdings and circulation.

➤ Rankings Report, xxxx Data (available in March)

Each municipality's rank within its population group and within the entire state based on its library's <u>per capita values</u> for certain income and expenditure data. For services, the indicators are: FTE per 10,000 population, MLS FTE per 10,000, hours open per week, direct and total circulation per capita and holdings per capita.

> Salaries Report, 7-1-xxxx (available in January)

Hourly minimum and maximum salaries for up to 17 public library position classifications from Library Director to Custodian. Annual salary for the Library Director is also displayed.

➤ Services Report, FYxxxx (available in January)

Services data includes number of terminals with Internet, average weekly visits, reference questions and hours open. Counts are provided for weekend days open, branches, adult and children's programs and attendance. Average hours open on weekends is also shown.

> Summary Tables and Graphs, xxxx Data (available in March)

Statewide, population group and regional totals of various incomes, expenditures, holdings, circulation, services and staffing data. Subject index provided.

Massachusetts Academic Library Data, Fall xxxx, Selected Statistics (available biennially)

Massachusetts Automated Resource Sharing Networks Report, FYxxxx (available in the winter)
